To whom it may concern

#### **Change of the set voltage to disconnect the battery in discharge mode**

The disconnection of the battery voltage point is slightly reduced to meet the requirements of UL2524. The UL requirements are 10.2V max. At present this voltage is not guaranteed in production, with some units have disconnection point at 10.2-10.4V

After modification the disconnection it will be typically 9.8V (min. 9.4 – 10.2V max.) to meet the UL2524 requirements with a margin for tolerance of components.

The product change is active for all models since production date 2022 CW25

Change details:

The changes will affect the set resistor (value change)
